



## Faculty Senate Proxy Statement

Faculty Senate Bylaws Section 1.2. A member of the Senate who is unable to attend a single meeting may designate a proxy for that meeting. An individual may only hold one proxy per meeting. All proxies must present to the Secretary to the Senate a written authorization signed by the designating member. A proxy must be qualified for membership in the Senate from the **same unit** as the designating member, except for at-large members.

Faculty Senate Bylaws Section 1.4. A senator who is absent from more than two regularly scheduled Senate meetings per year without a proxy shall be automatically dismissed from service on the Senate. At that time, the number required for quorum shall be reduced accordingly. The Senate Chair will then take action to see that a replacement from the same unit is named to fill the vacancy.
